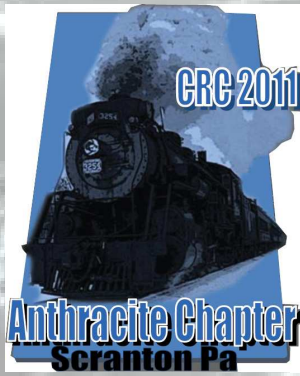

DIRECTIONS TO CRC 2011 HOTEL

From Points West

Take I-80 East
Exit LEFT onto I-81 North via EXIT 260B
Exit LEFT onto Central Scranton Expwy. via EXIT 185 (33.3 mi.)
Take RAMP to CENTRAL CITY (0.6 mi.)
Turn LEFT at traffic signal onto LACKAWANNA AVE (0.2 mi.)
HOTEL is immediately on the LEFT.

From Points Southwest

Take I-81 North
Exit LEFT onto Central Scranton Expwy. via PA EXIT 185
Take RAMP to CENTRAL CITY (0.6 mi.)
Turn LEFT at traffic signal onto LACKAWANNA AVE (0.2 mi.)
HOTEL is immediately on the LEFT.

From Points South

Take I-95 North
Exit RIGHT onto I-476 North via PA EXIT 7
Exit RIGHT to PA-315/I-81 via EXIT 115
Bear RIGHT onto PA-315 North.
Exit RIGHT onto I-81 North
Exit LEFT onto Central Scranton Expwy. via EXIT 185 (8.7 mi.)
Take RAMP to CENTRAL CITY (0.6 mi.)
Turn LEFT at traffic signal onto LACKAWANNA AVE (0.2 mi.)
HOTEL is immediately on the LEFT.

Airport Information

The Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport (AVP) is only 8 miles from the conference hotel and is served by American Airlines, Continental Airlines, Delta Airlines, United Airlines, and U.S. Airways.

From the airport:

Take I-81 north
Exit LEFT onto Central Scranton Expwy. via EXIT 185 (6.4 mi.)
Take RAMP to CENTRAL CITY (0.6 mi.)
Turn LEFT at traffic signal onto LACKAWANNA AVE (0.2 mi.)
HOTEL is immediately on the LEFT.
